

Key Stage 4 (Year 11) 2022

In 2022 Wixams Academy pupils sat their first set of GCSE and Cambridge Nationals five years after the school opened in 2017. The 122 pupils achieved good results. On this page we show Department for Education key performance indicators to see how these outcomes were compared to pupils in Bedford Borough and Nationally. On the second page we show the grade distributions for the individual subjects.

The progress above is measured from the Key Stage 2 tests that the pupils took at Primary School at the end of year 6. A progress score of zero is judged to be the expected progress for pupils.

At Wixams Academy the progress score of 0.13 is above National and Bedford Borough average outcomes across 8 subjects. This broadly means just over 1 in 8 grades achieved at Wixams was a grade higher than expected nationally. From the table you can see that in Maths this goes up to 2 in 5 grades higher and is judged to be significantly above national progress.

The progress of Disadvantaged pupil from Year 6 SATs to Year 11 in 8 subjects was +0.12. The progress far exceeds the National Progress Score of -0.55 and the Bedford Borough score of -0.44. This broadly means that half the grades achieved at Wixams by disadvantaged pupils were a grade higher than expected nationally.

Grade 4 is similar to the previous Grade C. At Wixams 72% of pupils achieved this benchmark in both English and Maths. This is above Bedford Borough and National average % of pupils achieving these grades.
