Year 12 Subject Consultation Evening 11th July

Dear Parents/Carers

We are excited to announce that the Year 12 Subject Meetings will take place in person on **Tuesday 11**th **July** from 4:30pm until 7.30pm. Subject teachers are looking forward to discussing the progress students have made. You will receive a copy of the end of Year 12 report prior to the evening beginning. Subject staff will discuss progress across the year, methods to improve outcomes and UCAS predictions. Can I remind all parents and students that the process to increase UCAS predictions is meritocratic, students may agree a period (e.g. 2-3 months) where they will produce work at a higher standard to allow the member of staff confidence to increase the grade. Subject teachers will set an improvement target for all students at these meetings. Students are expected to record these targets on a proforma that will be given to them on the night. These targets will then be reviewed later in the academic year.

In some cases an appointment will be made for you to meet with myself or Miss Rahman (Assistant to Head of Sixth) to discuss overall academic progress or pastoral matters. You will be contacted in advance if this is the case.

The school uses the same online appointment booking system where you will be able to choose your own appointment times with your child's teachers and will receive emails confirming your appointments. There will only be one appointment for each teacher so if your child is taught more than one subject by a teacher all discussions will take place in this slot. Please see the booking link below:
