QUALITY FIRST TEACHING AND LEARNING

High expectations and excellent teaching ensure our students develop into inquisitive and active learners. Staff at Wixams incorporate a wide range of learning approaches into their teaching ensuring that students of all abilities thrive. Our 'Teach to the top' mantra ensures that all students are stretched whilst our structured support system allows teaching to be personalised so all can achieve. Our lessons are engaging, active and dynamic fostering a genuine love of learning in our students. Route 2: Queens Park>Harrowden Road> Shorstown>Cotton End>Wilstead> Wixams


