Year 12 and 13 Mock Exam Parent Review Evening Tuesday 30th January

Dear Parents/Carers

We are excited to announce that the Year 12 and 13 Subject Meetings will be an in-person event on **Tuesday 30th January** from 4.30pm until 7.30pm. The school day will run as normal with students attending timetabled lessons and prep. Subject teachers are looking forward to meeting you to discuss the progress students have made. Subject teachers will set an improvement target for all students at these meetings. Students are expected to record these targets on a proforma that will be given to them on the night. These targets will then be reviewed later in the academic year.

In some cases, where we have concerns regarding academic progress an appointment will be made for you to meet with myself and Miss Rahman (Deputy of Head of Sixth) to discuss overall academic progress and pastoral matters. These appointments will take place during the school day from the 31st January onwards.

The school uses an online appointment booking system where you will be able to choose your own appointment times with your child's teachers and will receive emails confirming your appointments. There will only be one appointment for each teacher so if your child is taught more than one subject by a teacher all discussions will take place in this slot.

Appointments will last a maximum of 10 minutes and take place in the assembly hall. You will need to sign in at reception at least 10 minutes prior to your first appointment. There will be refreshments in the dining hall and a waiting area in the hall. The teacher will call you by your child's name when they are available.
